

CONSENT TO FURNISH FIREARMS TO A MINOR

The undersigned, having first carefully read Section 12552 of the California Penal Code:

"Any person who furnishes a firearm, air gun, or gas-operated gun, designed to fire a bullet, pellet, or metal projectile to any minor under the age of 18 years, without the express or implied permission of the legal guardian of the minor, is guilty of a misdemeanor "...does hereby with full knowledge of the above statute expressly grant permission to the Western Los Angeles County Council, BSA and it's employees, agents or representatives, to furnish to the below mentioned minor a firearm, air gun, or gas-powered gun of the nature and type described in above quoted Section 12552 and may use same during the time said minor is at a camp of the Council, or a camp of another local council which is a part of the Boy Scouts of America or an authorized Troop event.

This authorization shall remain effective unless revoked in writing and delivered to the Troop Committee or the scout Council office.
